- Fran Tafer gave the Treasurer's report: now online with Eastman Credit Union; Fran Tafer has a square. She shared something about dues being \$12.50 and something regarding Shelly Kelly and Vicky Lowe before I took over minutes.
- Audrey Pantas shared information about upcoming events:
